Policy on wearing masks on campus

In regards to the subject matter, the Okayama University's "Policy on wearing masks on campus" was notified on March 27, and following this notice, all students were notified of "the policy on wearing masks in the classes, etc. after April 2023" on March 31. Pertaining to this policy, we ask all students of Shikata campus for your continued cooperation in wearing masks (non-woven) while on Shikata campus, considering the infection risks in the University Hospital.

As for Tsushima campus, the policy of wearing masks is as notified previously, and yet we would like to ask all students to continue to take the necessary measures to prevent infection.

[Shikata Campus]

- In principle, students are asked to continue wearing masks (non-woven) inside the buildings on campus
- Wearing masks outside the building is left to the discretion of each individual.

[Tsushima Campus]

- Wearing masks inside the building is advised; however, individual's preference is respected and removing the mask would not be prevented.
- Wearing masks outside the building is left to the discretion of each individual.

In principle, the rules for wearing masks inside and outside the building on campuses are as stated above; however, the instructors of the classes may, at their discretion, instruct students to wear or remove their masks in the class.
