Duration of the self-isolation period mentioned in 1. will be considered as the "authorized absence". Please submit the "Notification of authorized absence" following the instruction by the Instruction and Student section.

3. Other

- Please take the necessary measures to prevent infections on a daily basis.
- If you have the symptoms of the common cold, etc., please take a test using the COVID-19 antigen test kit (officially approved by the Japanese government) on your own.

^{*} In the case of close contact, if the result of a PCR test taken after 48 hours of the next day following the day of the last contact is "negative", the self-isolation period can be ended.
